Adhesives:

SFA™ is a general purpose acrylic adhesive with excellent ultimate adhesion to a broad range of substrates, which offers good chemical/oil resistance once the label is applied. It is well-suited for small, cylindrical labeling, and is glove friendly.

BC-20™ is a rubber-based adhesive that offers high initial tack, and adheres well when moisture or oil may be present during application.

Facestock:

Reverse Coated Bright Silver Metallized Paper is a silver metallized paper with the adhesive laminated to the metallized side of the sheet. This sheet provides excellent opacity and very good barrier characteristics to prevent oil migration from the packaging into the label.
